Every Sunday and each night of the week, he could be seen going from the Training School to Concord College to prepare uniforms and charts for his successful seasons.

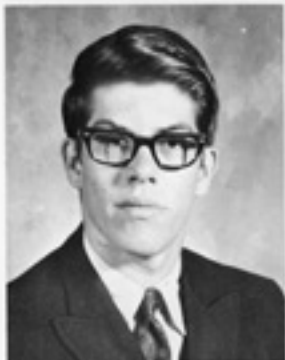

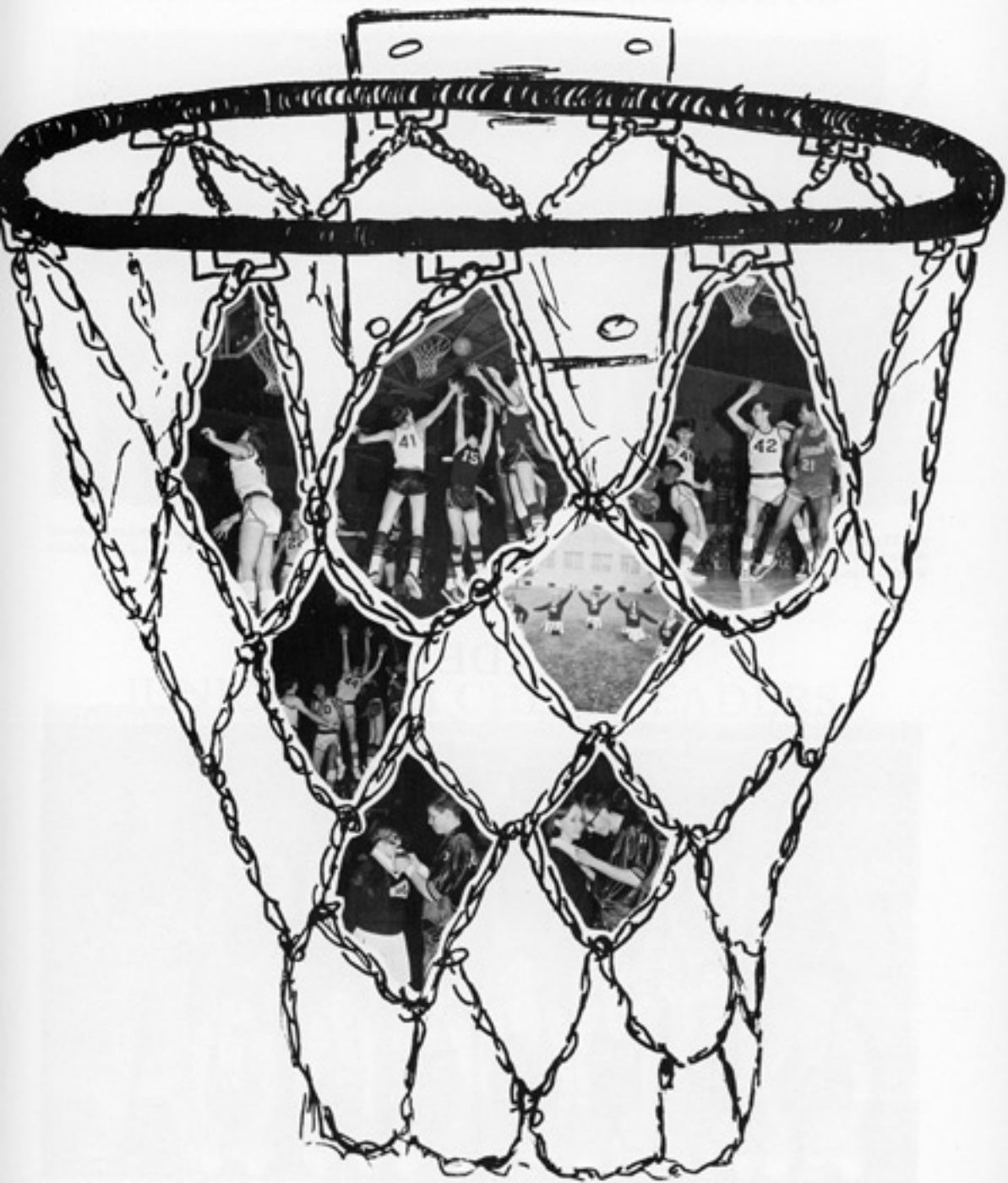

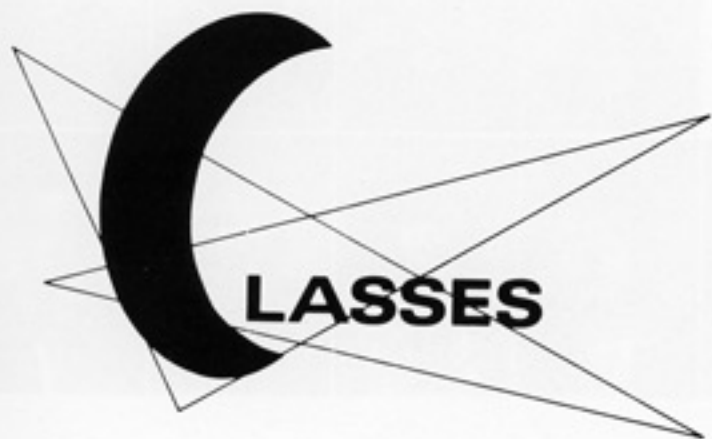
